

**GPE is the world's only partnership and fund focused exclusively on bringing quality education to children in low- and lower-middle-income-countries.**

## QUALITY



GPE supported **372 million children** with **better education** through grants and cofinancing from partners.

GPE grants and cofinancing have helped train **4.7 million teachers** (45% women) and distribute **272 million textbooks**.

## ACCESS



Close to **10 million more children** have been **enrolled** in school in partner countries.

## EQUITY AND INCLUSION



**51% of children** supported by GPE implementation grants are **girls**.

**70% of children** reached through GPE grants are in countries affected by **conflict** and **fragility**.

## LEARNING



85% of GPE grants that measured learning reported improvement in **learning**.\*

## FINANCING



Since 2018, GPE raised **\$4.7 billion** through innovative financing that otherwise may not have been invested in education.

**60%** of partner countries maintained their education budget at or above 20% of total spending or increased it.\*

## CLIMATE RESILIENCE



GPE investments in climate-resilient schools have helped partner countries save **\$2.5 billion** in potential damages from climate disasters.
